

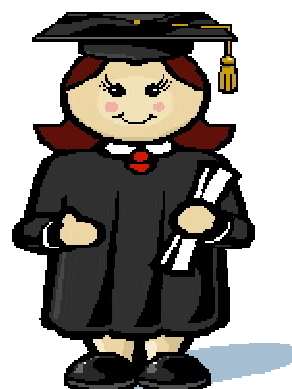

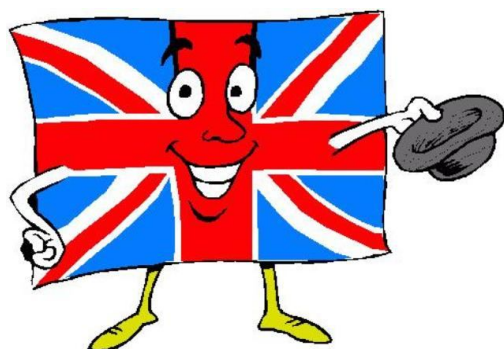

We like breaks, dinner meals and lessons.

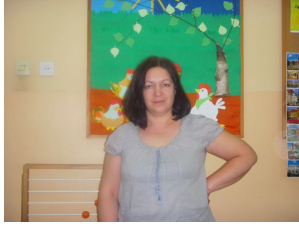
INTERVIEWS
