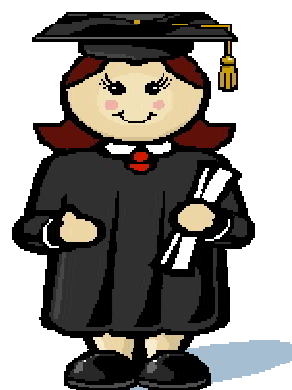

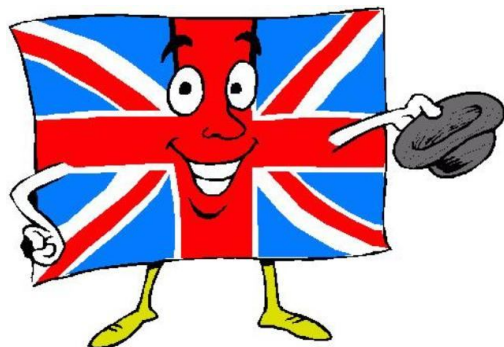

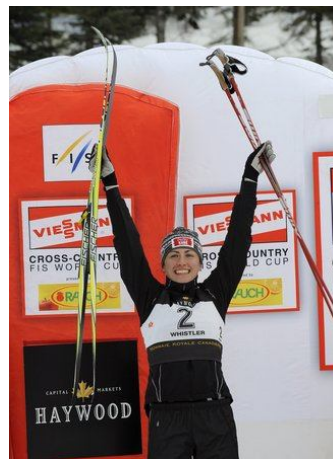
As everybody knows, our famous Polish F1 driver, Robert Kubica, had an accident while a Ronde di Andora race in Italy.

Every cordial gift is welcome. It doesn't matter whether these are flowers, perfumes or just a little something.

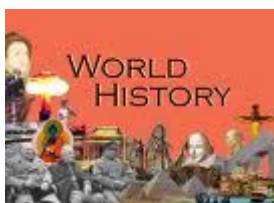
2. What do you think about editing a school magazine in English?

SELF-PRESENTATION COLUMN

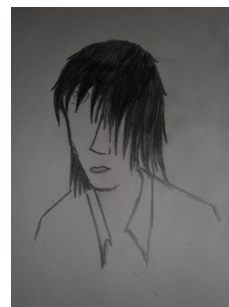
In each edition of " School Magazine" there will be presentations of different pupils from our school and their hobbies.
